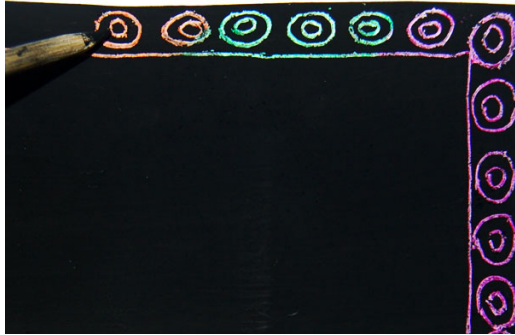


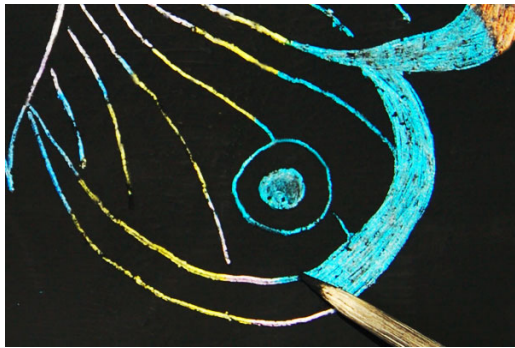
SCRATCH ART

Make an interesting picture by scratching lines and images on scratch art paper using the wooden scratching tool included in the packet.



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Think of a picture that you want to make. Use the tip of your scratching tool to scratch out lines and make patterns or images. As you scratch out lines and shapes, the colorful crayon layer beneath will show through.



2. Other than making lines, you can make shapes and even portraits or scratch out entire sections of black to create large colored areas.



3. Continue until you have completed your picture.

TIPS

1. You can sketch out your design in pencil first and then scratch out your lines..
2. Do not blow the bits of dried paint that you scratch off. Instead, let the particles slide off from the paper into a bin.
3. Have fun. Experiment. Don't be afraid to make mistakes. There is more paper.

- Scratch art paper (4)
- wooden scratching tool (1)
- Pencil (1)
- All included.
