Celebrate World AIDS Day with Day With(out) Art: Red Reminds Me... event including Live Performances organized by Vanessa Fros, Film Screenings, and Brunch by AO&Co at CAM on December 1



October 10, 2024 (St. Louis, MO)—The Contemporary Art Museum St. Louis commemorates World AIDS Day with a special event at the Museum, [Day With\(out\) Art: Red Reminds Me](#) on Sunday, December 1st from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. Hosted by the legendary Vanessa Frost, the event will feature unmissable live performances organized by Frost, a screening of videos commissioned by [Visual AIDS](#), a portion of the AIDS Memorial Quilt on display, and free HIV testing. Brunch by AO&Co will be available for a limited number of guests with the purchase of

a \$15 brunch ticket. Complimentary coffee and orange juice will be available for all guests; speciality coffee drinks and cocktails will be available for purchase at AO&Co at CAM. Tickets for the event will be available starting October 16 at camstl.org.

Day With(out) Art is a national program that originated in 1989 on World AIDS Day as a celebration of lives and achievements of lost artists and colleagues. With participation from hundreds of organizations, Day With(out) Art encourages ongoing efforts to destigmatize and find a cure for HIV by showing care for those living with a positive status.

Red Reminds Me... will feature newly commissioned short videos by artists working across the world: **Gian Cruz** (Philippines), **Milko Delgado** (Panama), **Imani Harrington** (USA), **David Oscar Harvey** (USA), **Mariana Iacono and Juan De La Mar** (Argentina/Colombia), **Nixie** (Belgium), **Vasilios Papapitsios** (USA).
