CAM transforms into high-fantasy art and musical spectacular by Maxi Glamour for Faeded – a Pride Month celebration on June 6



May 21, 2025 (St. Louis, MO)—The Contemporary Art Museum St. Louis (CAM) invites the community to kick off Pride Month with [First Friday: Faeded](#), a high-fantasy art and musical spectacular organized by Maxi Glamour. This year's infamous costume party honors fluidity, the magic of water, and the rivers that surround us—offering femmes, Queers, people of color, and those that love them space for joy and imaginative self-expression. Faeded is free to attend and open to the public, and will take place at CAM on Friday, June 6, from 6:00 pm—9:00 pm.

Starting at 6:00 pm, Faeded attendees are invited to explore the Artist and Vendor Marketplace featuring a variety of vibrant creations by queer makers and artists such as Black Tulip Chorale, Comet Crowbar, Creations from the Narcoleptic Mind, Gemini Daze, Jessica Boyer, Laura Coppinger, Metal Priestess, Natalie Welborn (Welborn Papercuts), Nella Baduini, Olivia Ng0zitheflower, Patrick Tramble, Ryvin Ue, Rome, and Saturfae. The evening also includes an interactive art-making station where guests can craft their own Pride buttons and Vivent Health will be providing free on-site HIV testing. Enjoy complimentary light bites and drinks will be available for purchase at CAM.

Beginning at 7:00 pm, live performances will take center stage, featuring a lineup of dynamic artists including DJ Rico Steez, Drum Warriors Ensemble, KV the Writer, Terri the Harp Lady, and Maxi Glamour Experience. The celebration will extend beyond the museum's doors with a free afterparty at Sophie's Artist Lounge, located at 3333 Washington Blvd., starting at 9:00 pm.
